



NWCCA ANTITRUST POLICY STATEMENT

Policy Statement for Association Meetings:

Meeting procedures will follow NWCCA's Parliamentary Procedures and adhere to NWCCA antitrust policy. These guidelines are designed to avoid significant penalties for violation of antitrust laws by the organization and its members. As a reminder, the meeting will be conducted according to the published agenda and there should not be any type of discussion or agreement among members that covers pricing, market division or allocation, bid coordination, sales terms, or specific profit or price information. If these topics do arise, the meeting will be stopped and the discussion returned to the approved agenda items. These procedures should be followed prior to the start of the meeting and after the meeting is concluded. If questions arise about the appropriateness of the discussions at a meeting, it should be directed immediately to the NWCCA President, Executive Director or NWCCA legal counsel.
